Results Wrap

Woodville South 284 def Hectorville 218

The A grade travelled out to Hectorville to have a shot at back to back wins and climb further up the ladder. Starting the match off with ball in hand it was a typical good start for the Cats grabbing early wickets whilst keeping the run rate down. With the absence of Anthony Caruso, Adam Johnson led the attack taking 3/26, with handy contributions from Ryan Standing and Kris Hennessy grabbing two wickets apiece. The Hounds didn't give up easy though and put up a fight to be eventually bowled out for 218, which left the Cats having to face a tricky couple of overs at the end of day one, but managed to get through unscathed.

We lost an early one on day two, but it didn't have any lasting effect. James Schebella (78), who made his top A Grade score and Damien Seekamp, who continued his stunning run of form, but fell one run short of making it back to back tons, put on a 152 run partnership. The second wicket fell at 166 which brought Jimmy Espagne (53) out to put a bit of icing on the cake, notching up another half century. We lost a few wickets late in the day but with the game wrapped up only two wickets down it wasn't going to dampen a good day for the Cats.

Woodville South 93 & 152 def by Grange 192 & 0/54

After getting off the season with a 3-1 record the B Grade took on Grange at Ledger Reserve. It was a disappointing game for the side to say the least. Having a bat first, we lost our first wicket with the first ball of the day, and things didn't get much better from there being bowled out for 93. Addy Singh (28) battled hard but unfortunately he didn't have much assistance. With that behind us, we had 44 overs to have a crack at knocking the Dolphins over. It was a credit to the bowlers the way they went about trying to defend a low total. Kym Gaylard (4/42) was on fire early, having Grange 2/1. Addy Singh (2/42)

and Hayden Niscioli (3/40) combined together to give the guys a real chance of victory when Grange lost their 6th wicket for 64 runs. Grange were able to hold firm though and pass the score losing no more wickets and eventually being bowled out early on day two for 192.

We started off our second innings with a 99 run deficit which we passed 4 wickets down with Garth Newton making 30 and Kym Gaylard top scoring with 34. Much like the first innings though we lost too many wickets for too few runs and were bowled out with a 53 run lead with 13 overs remaining. The bowlers did their best to try and restrict the runs but the lead proved to be not enough as Grange passed the score without loss.

Woodville South 9/163 def by Pembroke 2/165

The C Grade was home against Pembroke. We had a bat first and Harrison Phillips (50) showed what he can do making his first half century for the season and Luke Griffiths (41) batted very well as the two put on a 56 run 4th wicket partnership. Greg Buttfield put in a handy contribution with 19 to set us up to posting a competitive 163 after 40 overs.

Pembroke looked to go out on the attack early and on a flat Nazareth pitch and fast outfield it paid off, as they were able to pass the score only two down with 16 overs still to remain. Griffo (1/34) picked up one along with Adrian Winskill (1/28).
